

# Tomas L. Griebeling

Dr. Griebeling holds the John P. Wolf 33<sup>rd</sup> Masonic Distinguished Professorship in the Department of Urology and The Landon Center on Aging at the University of Kansas School of Medicine. He served for several years as the Senior Associate Dean for Medical Education for the KU School of Medicine with oversight for UME, GME, and CME.

He earned his BA in biology, chemistry, and sociology from Wartburg College (Waverly, IA), and his medical degree from the University of Iowa College of Medicine. He remained at Iowa for both his urology residency and fellowship training. He earned his Master of Public Health (MPH) from the University of Kansas.

Dr. Griebeling is President of the Geriatric Urological Society of the AUA, and current Historian and Past-President of the AUA South Central Section. He is Past-Chair of the Health Sciences Section of the Gerontological Society of America. He serves in Editorial Board positions for several journals including the Journal of Urology; Urology (The Gold Journal); and International Urology and Nephrology. He has received multiple teaching awards during his career, and the Distinguished Service Award from the AUA. He currently serves on the AUA History Committee, and the AUA Committee on Diversity, Equity, and Inclusion (DEI).

He is internationally recognized for his expertise in geriatric urology and has published and presented extensively in this field. He holds fellowship status in the American College of Surgeons (FACS), the Gerontological Society of America (FGSA), and the American Geriatrics Society (AGSF).
